


# GETTING STARTED

BEFORE USING YOUR HMT DEVICE, YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 Install the latest firmware update for the GC2
- 2 Assemble the HMT mount and connect the devices (as shown)
- 3 Apply markers to clubs (as shown)
- 4 Place GC2 and attached HMT on flat, level hitting surface and then power the GC2 on. (The HMT draws power from the GC2)

**CAUTION:** The HMT device is designed to detach from its magnetic base if struck by a ball. Use caution when moving or picking up assembly to avoid detachment and damage to device.




Solid green light indicates ball is within hitting zone.

# APPLYING CLUB MARKERS


## ► How to apply markers

**IMPORTANT!** Before applying markers, thoroughly clean the face of all clubs with rubbing alcohol to ensure markers will adhere firmly.


**A** Remove the marker from the marker sheet using the clear peel tab. Avoid touching the marker with your finger.



**B** Position the marker over the club face, cross-hair side up.




**C** Align the crosshairs on the marker with the score lines, and press firmly. Carefully peel the clear tab away from the applied marker, leaving only the marker on the face.




## ► Marker placement on drivers

**1** Count the club's score lines to determine the vertical center of the club face.




Note: For clubs with an even number of score lines, the vertical face center will be between the center two score lines. For clubs with an odd number of score lines, the vertical face center will be directly on the center score lines.

**2** Carefully apply the first two markers along the vertical center of the face near the outer edge of the score lines\*, keeping both markers level with each other.



The center point between these two markers will define the horizontal center of the face.

**3** Carefully apply the last two markers on the toe of the club face at the top and bottom edges of the ball strike zone.



**4** With all 4 markers correctly placed on the club face, your driver is now ready to record data with the HMT device. PLEASE NOTE: All 4 markers MUST be on the club face to correctly capture data.



## ► Marker placement on irons

**1** From the bottom of the club, count 6 score lines up to find the approximate vertical hitting center.



**2** Carefully apply the first two markers between the sixth and seventh score lines at the toe and heel, keeping both markers level with each other\*. The center point between these two markers will define the horizontal center of the face.



**3** Carefully apply the last two markers on the toe of the club face at the top and bottom edges of the ball strike zone.



**4** With all 4 markers correctly placed on the club face, your iron is now ready to record data with the HMT device. PLEASE NOTE: All 4 markers MUST be on the club face to correctly capture data.






## 1 ASSEMBLE MOUNTING ARM




## 2 RAISE LCD SCREEN ON GC2




## 3 ATTACH MOUNT PLATE TO GC2




## 4 ATTACH ARM TO MOUNT PLATE
